# Derry Football Association Policy and Procedure Acknowledgement Form

## **Refund Policy**

A participant is entitled to a 100% refund by **requesting a refund from the board in writing before the start of the second day of practice.** Refund requests may be sent to the Derry Demons, P.O. Box 118, Derry, NH 03038. All equipment must be turned in before any refunds are issued.

## **Fundraising/Volunteering Policy**

As a non-profit organization, the Derry Demons depend on volunteers and fundraising to keep our organization successful. Fundraising is an important aspect of raising revenue for the Demons and every family's participation in fundraising is mandatory. Each family is also expected to assist with volunteering as well.

## **Member Code of Ethics**

- I pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for the children participating in youth sports.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at all games, practices or organizational events.
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of the children ahead of my personal desire to win.
- I will support the parents/coaches/officials working with the children in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience.
- I will remember that the game is for the youths, not the adults.
- I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for the children.
- I will encourage all the children to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect.
- I agree to follow the Chain of Command should an issue arise that I am not comfortable with or do not understand.
- I will: 1. Speak to the Parent/Head Coach 2. Speak to the Football/Cheering Coordinator 3. Speak to the President

## **Behavior and/or Violence**

The Derry Demon Board of Officers has the right to impose one or more of the following sanctions toward any Parent(s), Legal Guardian(s) or Individual(s) who becomes verbally abusive or violent.

1. Probation for one or more games and practices, which includes a "Zero Tolerance" policy for the duration of the probation and balance of the season.
2. Suspension for one or more games, in which the individual is not allowed at games or practices for the duration of the suspension and to include a "Zero Tolerance" policy for the duration of the probation and the balance of the season.
3. Refuse to register or bar during the season children of violent parents or legal guardian only after the above sanctions have been followed or in extreme cases. A child's participation with the Derry Demons is a privilege not a Constitutional Right. Therefore, as long as the sanctions are based solely on the actions of the violator and not based on sex, color, religion, etc., it is not discrimination.

## Welcome to New Hampshire Youth Football & Spirit Conference

You and your child (son/daughter/ward) are making a commitment to learn a sport that will demand time, hard work and sacrifices. We believe that it will be a meaningful and rewarding experience in our Football and Cheerleading programs.

The NHYFSC has over 4,000 participants. The Conference stresses that conditioning and safety are paramount. Nevertheless, you should be aware that in spite of all reasonable precautions, injuries could happen. Football/Cheerleading is a collision/contact sport, and even the best equipment will not always prevent an injury due to the many random factors involved in contact. Football teams are offered as a grade based division and Middle School (Jr. Varsity/Varsity) division. Spirit squads are offered in age appropriate and ability levels. Each association selects their coaching staffs.

Football/Cheerleading is not an excuse to put schoolwork aside! The NHYFSC prides itself in the scholastic rankings achieved by its member associations. Football/Cheerleading will compliment the learning experience but never replace it. As a condition of membership, all persons associated with the NHYFSC and its member associations agree to follow all National Affiliation, NHYFSC, and local rules and regulations.

The NHYFSC has a commitment to provide a positive environment for the youth participating in our program. It is necessary that parents, fans, etc. understand that negative and unsportsmanlike behavior impacts the positive environment. Therefore, the NHYFSC expects the parents, fans, etc. to refrain from the behavior, and comply with any and all request made by local and/or state officials while attending any Event.

I agree to submit a copy of my son / daughter / ward's last year's report card or a written statement of scholastic fitness by the school administration.

**4) Medical Clearance** - Because your child is involved in an active sport, there may be an occasion when an injury occurs that requires medical treatment and we are unable to contact you. This situation may occur at team functions, practices or at games both home and away (possibly out of state).

**5) Image Release** - In consideration of my minor child / ward being allowed to participate in any NHYFSC, local association and national affiliate related events and activities, I agree that the NHYFSC, local association and National Affiliate have the unrestricted and exclusive right and permission, free from approval or review, to copyright and use in all media now and hereafter known, including but not limited to, pictures and videos of my child which he/she may be included intact or in part for promotion or other commercial use.

**6) Adult Behavior Compliance** - I agree to comply with all NHYFSC, local association and/or national affiliation guidelines. This specifically applies to acts by me or my family members that are abusive to administrators, coaches, game officials, and other players. Also, I and my family members will not use vulgar language or comments around the playing area nor shall it be directed at any individual.
